The escapement is lightweight and strong, thanks to the use of MEMS technology. With the push of the reset button, the hands return instantly to zero in perfect synchronization. The contrasting color scheme of red and blue used for the main dial, the chronograph scale and the hands delivers maximum legibility and echoes that of the 1969 original.
