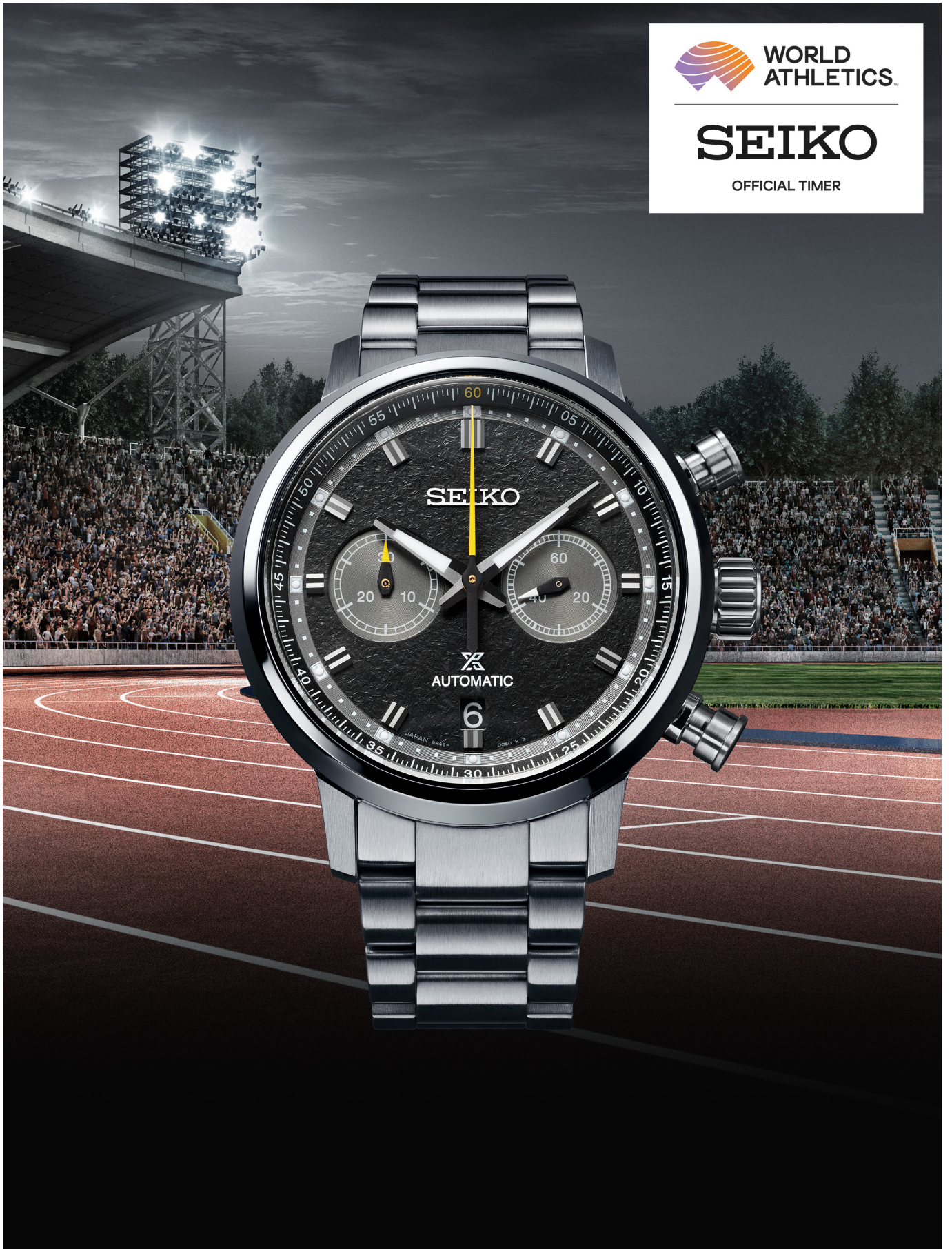

In the 1960's, Seiko announced itself on the world's sporting stage with a suite of timing devices that set a new global standard of precision. In 1969, these time measurement skills were applied to a wristwatch in the form of a chronograph called the Seiko Speedtimer which was the world's first automatic chronograph with a vertical clutch. Seiko's tradition as a pioneer in sports timing has continued and, since 1985, Seiko has been the timekeeper of choice of World Athletics. In 2022, for the 17th time, Seiko will deliver its state-of-the-art timing services at the World Championships which will take place in Eugene, Oregon. With its sand patterned dial and with the event emblem printed on the sapphire case back, this new Speedtimer Limited Edition Chronograph celebrates the sporting heritage of the venue and honors the performances of the approximately 1,800 athletes who will take part. This watch is offered as a limited edition of 400.
