A powerful design. A tough exterior. And a delicate dial pattern.

Not long after its first appearance in 2007, this watch was given the name 'Sumo' by its many fans. Perhaps it was its muscular appearance or perhaps it was that the bezel's shape resembles the Dohyo or ring where Sumo takes place but the name stuck and it gained wide recognition as a robust and trusted watch for divers.

This new generation inherits the 2007 design but offers added strength

in the form of a ceramic bezel and a super-hard coating for the case and the bracelet. The three-row bracelet is also new, as is the design of the solid clasp. Two of the dials, one blue and one grey, have a subtle texture that evokes the graceful motion of the oceans while the third carries the name PADI and its globe shape emblem.
